

Conclusins of NASE Course in Lima, Peru.

In 2012, the NASE training in Peru should be modified due to changes in the local organization.

The days were reduced, and the workshops , conferences and working groups addapted for the best use of time. Therefore, the closing day teachers reported that training had been too short, they would have liked more time to develop the themes. According to the general discussion, the professors argued that some of the issues presented were relatively complex due to the level at which these subjects are taught in the career of teachers. It became clear that the workshops, and practical work are applicable to the classroom and they value especially those working outdoors, because outdoor experience with reality allow and facilitate the union of theory and practice

The contents of Astronomy in Peru, are taught mainly in primary level education especially in the areas of the Natural Sciences. These days, as part of the activities at the University, with the possibility of assistance from students who are training to be teachers at different levels, was highly valued and advocated the continuation of training in Astronomy and Astrophysics of high quality, sponsored by the University and the IAU.

There was a positive feedback from teachers, emphasizing the teaching method applied in NASE, the utility of all knowledge and its acquisition, provided easily and practice.
