

Conclusions of NASE Course in Tegucigalpa, Honduras

As a final activity in the “**II Taller de Capacitación en la Enseñanza de la Astronomía en la Escuela**”, was coordinated a working group on the Teaching of Astronomy in Honduras. The exchange of ideas was broad; it manifested great enthusiasm of the participants.

The conclusions reached were:

- 1) Participants opinion polls shows an overall satisfaction on the development of the “**II Taller de Capacitación en la Enseñanza de la Astronomía en la Escuela**”
- 2) The workshops by their educational appearance and their applicability in schools, received the highest scores.
- 3) As for the conference, most felt that although all had great content, it should be added that of Archaeoastronomy Maya.
- 4) The same poll shows a high appreciation for the preparation of instructors and their availability to answer inquiries from participants, so it is considered that the Department of Astronomy and Astrophysics has a team competent for the development and installation of these events.
- 5) The city tour was a welcome activity, as they do not only spoke of the historical sites in downtown Tegucigalpa, but were shown the astronomical aspect involved in its construction and is invited the people who came from inside the country, to conduct similar research in the architecture of their communities.

And the recommendations suggested were:

- 1) Develop more NASE workshops in different parts of the country through the organization of educational networks.
- 2) Invite in later days the participants to share their experiences in the classroom, to develop activities learned during NASE.
- 3) Improve conditions of the Jorge Sahade Hall to provide a better environment for participants.
