

## Conclusions

### NASE course. La Réunion Island (France) 2022

The number of registrations to the NASE on-line training sessions in France in February and March 2022 was about 60 and we unexpectedly got half of those coming from La Réunion, a French island in the Indian Ocean. The fewer teacher-training sessions organised there can explain this enthusiasm; after all, teachers from La Réunion are also eager to learn more about astronomy! We therefore organised dedicated sessions since La Réunion is in the Southern hemisphere and thus needs an adapted treatment and discourse.

The first session on February 2<sup>nd</sup> was a little disturbed by an approaching cyclone and, consequently, some teachers could not attend because of a 2 day-lockdown, but it went globally well. About 10 teachers actually attended the sessions.
